

Corban University Online Completion Scholarship

Complete your degree – earn a scholarship!

The Corban University Online Scholarship is designed to help you finish well. All Online Undergraduate students will be eligible to receive a scholarship covering the final 10% of their tuition, which could be up to \$5,040.

How it works:

- Apply to a Corban University Online program.
- Once you are accepted and enrolled for the Fall 2018 semester, automatically qualify for the scholarship.
- Start working toward your degree.
- Receive a copy of your scholarship certificate by mail and by email *after* the fall class drop deadline, as long as you remain enrolled.
- Keep your certificate!
- Present your certificate to Corban's Financial Aid department when you begin the final 10% of your Corban Online credits—usually your final semester. Your scholarship will be processed and added to your Financial Aid Award Letter.

Eligibility and Award Details

- All Corban University Online undergraduate students beginning Fall 2018 or later will qualify for the scholarship upon admission or readmission to the online undergraduate program.
- Students will be awarded a scholarship to cover the final 10% of credits taken consecutively through Corban University Online.
- A student who is not actively enrolled in online courses for more than 1 year (3 semesters) will forfeit their scholarship.
- Readmit students may qualify for the completion scholarship. The scholarship amount will be determined based on the total credits taken after readmission.
- The student will be issued a certificate – by mail and by email – that will document the number of credits qualifying for the scholarship and the expiration date of the scholarship.

- Any changes to the student degree plan, including additional transfer credits, Credit for Prior Learning, or CLEP exams, may reduce the number of credits taken through Corban University Online and may therefore reduce the total scholarship awarded.
- The expiration date of the scholarship will be determined based on the number of credits required to complete the student's degree.
- The student will be responsible for alerting Financial Aid of their award and presenting the certificate when they enter the final 10% of their courses.
- The scholarship amount will not exceed the tuition cost of 12 semester credits. Students who need fewer than 10 credits to finish their degree when they enroll at Corban will qualify for a scholarship covering 1 semester credit.
- The completion scholarship may only be stacked with the visit scholarship. Athletic scholarships, academic scholarships, or employee tuition benefits will take precedence over the completion scholarship and cannot be combined with the completion scholarship.
